PROJECT REVIEW

Which agencies and by what process will review your project be reviewed?

- Administrative Review (staff)
- · Zoning Board (hearing)
- Planning Commission (hearing)
- City Council/Board of Supervisors (hearing)



Was your project approved or denied?

- Approved
 - Move to next phase
- Denied
 - Appeal
 - Resubmit with
 - modifications
 - Change project and apply

IF APPROVED

What other agencies will review?

- Building Dept.
- Fire Dept.
- \cdot Transportation Dept.
- Public Works
- Environmental Health

IF WRONGLY DENIED AT APPEAL

What do you do if you go through the entire administrative process, including an appeal, and your project is wrongly denied?

QUESTIONS THAT DETERMINE YOUR CLAIMS

- Did the agency proceed without, or in excess of, jurisdiction?
- Did you recieve a fair trial?
- Was there a prejudicial abuse of discretion?
 - Failure to proceeded in the manner required by law
 - The decision is not supported by the findings
 - The findings are not supported by the evidence
 - Civil Rights claims (e.g. Equal Protection)
